

BY-LAW NO. 12/97

Being a By-Law of the Village of Teulon for the regulation of business, business activities and persons engaged in business.

WHEREAS Section 232(1) authorizes a Municipality to pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters:

- (n) businesses, business activities and persons engaged in business;

AND WHEREAS Section 232(2) of the Municipal Act sets out the regulatory by-law making powers;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Teulon deems it advisable to pass by-law for the regulation of business within the Village of Teulon;

NOW THEREFORE THE Council of the Village of Teulon in open assembly enacts as follows:

TITLE


This by-law may be referred to as "the Village of Teulon Business Licence By-Law".


DEFINITIONS

- 1) In this by-Law the following terms have the following meaning:
  - a) "Business" shall include any trade, occupation or calling, transient traders, peddlers or hawkers, whether or not it is carried on continuously or on an intermittent or one-time basis.
  - b) "Person" shall mean an individual, firm, partnership or corporation.
- 2) The Council of the Village of Teulon shall require persons who do not reside or have a place of business in the Village to report to the Municipal Office before conducting business in the Village; and
- 3) Require pawnbrokers to report all transactions by pawn or purchase to the head of Council or to the police; and
- 4) Require those persons as described under Section 1 of this By-Law to purchase a Business Licence at a fee of \$50.00 (Fifty Dollars).
- 5) The Council of the Village of Teulon does not require that a licence be obtained to sell produce grown in Manitoba if the sale is by the individual who produced it or an immediate family member or employee of the individual.
- 6) All licences issued pursuant to this by-law shall expire on December 31st next following the issuance of such licence. Licences must be renewed on January 1st of each and every year or at the time the person commences business within the Village whichever occurs sooner. Any party obtaining a licence in any year shall pay the amount of the licence fee prescribed in Section 4 of this By-Law irrespective of how many days are left in the year, or how many days he will carry on business.

- 7) Any person who carries on business without having acquired the necessary business licence shall be subject to a penalty not exceeding twice the amount of the applicable licence fee. Said penalty shall be payable directly to the Village of Teulon and such penalty shall be in addition to the appropriate business licence fee which such person must obtain in addition to paying the penalty.
- 8) Any person who breaches any provision of this by-law other than the failure to obtain the necessary licence shall be subject to a fine not exceeding FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) and to imprisonment for a term not exceeding ONE (1) MONTH, or to both such fine and such imprisonment. Where the contravention, refusal, neglect, omission or failure, continues for more than one (1) day, the person is guilty of a separate offence for each day that it continues.
- 9) That all By-Laws previously enacted by the Village of Teulon in force on the date of this By-Law coming into force which in any way contradict, limit or restrict the effect of this By-Law are hereby repealed.
- 10) This By-Law shall come into full force and effect on January 1, 1998.
